


MISSION STATEMENT

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Dennis P. Tarnow, DDS - KEYNOTE SPEAKER

Dr Dennis Tarnow is currently Clinical Professor of Periodontology and Director of Implant Education at Columbia School of Dental Medicine. Dr. Tarnow has a certificate in Periodontics and Prosthodontics and is a Diplomate of the American Board of Periodontology. He is a recipient of the Master Clinician Award from the American Academy of Periodontology and Teacher of the Year Award from New York University. Dr. Tarnow has a private practice in New York City, and has been honored with a wing named after him at New York University College of Dentistry. He has published over one hundred articles on perio-prosthodontics and implant dentistry and has coauthored three textbooks including one in 2008 titled <u>Aesthetic Restorative Dentistry</u>. Dr. Tarnow has lectured extensively in the United States and internationally in over thirty countries.

Sander Polonco, OT Labs, MDT






John Heimke, DDS - GUEST LECTURER


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
